
How to enter coordinates and create graphs in EquatIO


1. Once in EquatIO, select the Graph Editor option:

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2. Enter your coordinates in the left panel. Use one row for each coordinate. You can use labels to name your coordinates:



3. Enter your equations in the left panel. Use one row for each equation:



4. Select **Insert Graph** to finish and insert the graph.

EquatIO's Graph Editor options

Change the settings of your graph by going to the graph's **Settings** option. You can add labels here to name your X-axis and Y-axis, as well as change the range of units to be displayed:
